

## **APPENDIX II**

### **NEMF FORAY SAMPLE PROGRAM SCHEDULE (Two Sheets)**

**The following Program Schedule is a sample of what a typical program might contain. There are slide presentations for the general assembly gatherings, round table discussions, awards program, etc. Special interest programs may include slide lectures, workshops, and video viewings, etc. This sample program consists of 12-exempt faculty guests, and 2-nonexempt faculty guests. The number of faculty, both exempt and nonexempt is determined during the financial planning (see Appendix I), and may vary depending on the fixed facility expenses.**

**The “Meeting of the Trustees/Directors”, which is required at each annual NEMF Foray, should not be scheduled on the last day of the Foray. A minimum of 2-hours should be reserved for the meeting, and an effort should be made not to schedule any major programs during that time period.**

**Some faculty guests may conduct more than one program or presentation, with or without additional compensation; for example, a guest may be willing to make an evening presentation to the general assembly, and also conduct a classroom lecture. In any event, the Program Chairman must stay within the “Faculty” budget as determined in the “Financial Planning Worksheets”. Any deviation from the budget must be authorized by the Executive Committee.**

**A biography may be included in the “Printed Programs”, describing the faculty, their speciality, if any, their mycological affiliations, and their mycological credentials, if any. Thereafter, the scheduled programs shall identify the respective faculty guests by name only, and not by mycological credentials, so as not to differentiate between professional mycologists and “noncredentialed”, mycological experts.**
