



GENEVA POINT CENTER Useful Information

Since 1919, Geneva Point Center has accommodated summer camps, Christian fellowships, family reunions, and a variety of conferences and retreats. The campus is over 200 acres in size, and the many outdoor activities include swimming at the beach, kayaking or canoeing, nature trail walks, tennis, volleyball, horseshoes, and field sports. There are a few useful bits of information that are reprinted here to make your stay more enjoyable:

Check-in: After 1 pm on Thursday

Check-out: by 10 am on Sunday

Mail: goes out each day at 9 am from Admin. Bldg.

Meals: All meals are served in the Dining Hall, which is the lower floor of the Inn (except Barbecue).

Messages: mail and messages will be kept in a temporary box at the Administration Building. Also, at the Inn on the porch.

Parking: Behind Admin Bldg. after you unload (1 car per room allowed at Gibbes House and Lakeview Lodge).

Phones: two pay phones: 1 in Gibbes House and 1 downstairs in the Meeting House.

Photocopies: 10 cents per copy at the Admin. Building.

Rest Rooms: Admin. Building, Inn 1st floor, Meeting House (both floors), Shower House, Gibbes House & Lakeview Lodge meeting spaces.

Valuables: Can be left in safe in Admin. Building.
